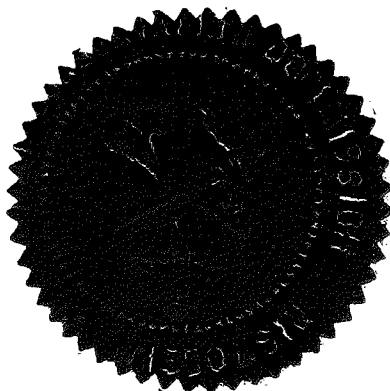

IN THE MATTER of repealing section WCD

23.01 (1b); amending sections WCD 23.03 (2);  
WCD 23.05 (2), (3) and (4); WCD 23.06 (1)

Order No. F-254  
(Revised 1)

and repealing and recasting section WCD  
23.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code  
relating to open and closed seasons, bag limits,  
size limits, possession limits and other  
regulations for the taking of fish in the  
Wisconsin-Michigan boundary waters.

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN  
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission  
of Wisconsin by sections 29.05 and 29.17<sup>1/2</sup>, Wis. Stats., the State  
Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends and repeals  
rules as follows:

Section WCD 23.01 (1b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is  
repealed.

Section WCD 23.02 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed  
and recreated to read:

WCD 23.02 Seasonal limits. There are provided and established  
the following open and closed seasons, bag limits, size limits,  
possession limits and other fishing regulations for the several  
varieties and species of fish in the waters herein designated. A  
closed season is established for each variety of fish named herein  
extending during all the time of the year except the open season  
period embraced within the specified dates, both inclusive, and  
except as otherwise expressly provided no person or persons shall  
take, catch, or kill fish of any variety, or fish for fish by any  
means other than with hook and line; nor at any time other than the  
open season thereof nor have in his possession or under his control  
any fish, in excess of the daily bag or possession limit or below the  
minimum size therefor during the open season.

In the Mendota river, Bad Water lake, the Montreal river from the power dam in section 15, township 48 north, range 49 west, Gogebic county, Michigan, and section 7, township 47 north, range 1 east, Iron county, Wisconsin downstream to its mouth, and in the Brule river from U.S. highway #2 bridge in section 9, township 41 north, range 32 west, Iron county, Michigan and in section 12, township 40 north, range 17 west, Florence county, Wisconsin, downstream to its mouth.

(12) MEASUREMENT OF FISH. The measurement of all fish taken shall be in a straight line from the tip of the snout to the utmost end of the tail fin fully extended.

Section WCD 23.03 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 23.03 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to take, catch, or kill fish, or fish for fish of any variety from any boat while being propelled by motor or sail, or while in tow of a motorboat or sailboat, in the waters of Lac Vieux Desert, Lake Menominee, Crooked (East Bay) Lake, West Bay Lake, Big Lake, and Tenderfoot Lake.

WCD 23.02 (2) Northern pike or pickerel, but no other species of fish, may be taken by means of spears through the ice from the first Saturday in January to February 28, inclusive, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., central standard time, subject to the bag, possession and size limits prescribed for such fish in section WCD 23.02.

(3) Rough fish may be taken by means of spears from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., central standard time, only from the Saturday nearest April 1 to May 31 in the waters of Menominee river.

(4) Cisco and whitefish may be taken by means of spears from the Saturday nearest October 15 to December 31 of each year in the waters of Snakey lake. Such spearing may be done in either the daytime or at night and with the aid of artificial lights.

Section WCD 23.06 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 23.06 Dip nets. (1) Dip nets may be used for taking rough fish and smelt from the Saturday nearest April 1 to May 14 inclusive in the Menominee river, except that it shall be unlawful to use any dip net in that part of the Menominee river beginning at the upstream side of the Little Street bridge in Marinette-Menominee and extending upstream to the first dam and within 200 feet below all other dams.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1962.
