ORDER OF THE STATE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.065 and 29.174, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends and repeals rules as follows:

Section WCD 22.03 (16) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 22.03 (16) Crayfish. There shall be an open season for the taking of crayfish from the Saturday nearest May 1 to March 1, both dates inclusive, with no bag limit and no size limit.

Section WCD 22.08 (4) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 22.08 (4) SET OR BANK POLES (see Hooks). Set or bank poles (see Hooks) may be used for the taking, catching, killing or fishing for catfish 13 inches or over in length, haddock sturgeon 25 inches or over in length, bullheads and rough fish only, during the period of time extending from the Saturday nearest May 1 to the next succeeding October 31; size limits shall conform to the provisions of section WCD 22.09. In such fishing it shall be unlawful to use any game fish or frog, either dead or alive as bait.
