ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN  
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends and repeals the rules as follows:

Section WCD 24.01 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 24.01 Clamming in inland waters. (1) SEASONS; LIMITS. There shall be maintained in the inland waters of the state of Wisconsin, not including the waters forming a common boundary between the states of Wisconsin and Minnesota and Wisconsin and Iowa, the following open and closed seasons, bag limits, size limits, possession limits and other regulations for the taking of mussels and clams as specified. A closed season is established for the taking of mussels and clams for the entire period of each year except the open season period embraced within specified dates, both inclusive, and except as otherwise expressly provided, no person shall take, catch or kill, or attempt to take, catch or kill any mussels or clams at any time other than the open season therefor, nor in any manner other than as provided.

(c) All undersized mussels and clams shall be returned to the water without injury.			

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1962.
