

IN THE MATTER of amending Section WCD 45.09(3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code pertaining to boating regulations : on Tellowstone Lake.

Order No. M-959

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 23.09 and 23.11, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 45.09 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WOD 45.09 (3) On the waters of Yellowstone Lake in Lafayette County, Wisconsin, it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motorboat in a careless, negligent or reckless manner so as to endanger the life. property, or person of others, or to operate a motorboat at a speed greater than six miles per hour when within 200 feet of the shoreline. or to operate any motorboat in any area where notices are posted prohibiting the operation and use of motorboats. On the afore-mentioned waters, no person shall operate a motorboat towing a person on water skis, aquaplane, or similar device between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and the following 10:00 a.m., or without a competent person in the boat in addition to the operator who shall watch at all times for the safety of any person on waterskis, aquaplane, or similar device being towed by said boat. It is unlawful for any person to operate, anchor, moor or beach any houseboat or pontoon boat on the waters of Yellowstone Lake or on the land within the boundaries of the Yellowstone conservation area.

It is unlawful for any person to leave any boat unattended whether anchored, moored or beached on the waters of Yellowstone Lake or on lands within the boundaries of the Yellowstone conservation area except within such areas as are designated and posted for such purposes,

The rules contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1962.
