ORDER OF THE WISCONSIN BOARD OF EXAMINERS IN WATCHMAKING AMENDING RULES.

Pursuant to authority vested in the Wisconsin Board of Examiners in Watchmaking by sections 125.06 and 227.014(c), Wisconsin Statutes, the agency hereby amends rules as follows: Sections WATCH 1.18(2) and (5) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are amended to read:

WATCH 1.18(2) Applicant shall have received his certificate by passing a regularly conducted examination and not by exemption or shall have been registered and engaged in watchmaking for a period of not less than ten years.

WATCH 1.18(5) Reciprocity shall not be granted until after a personal interview with the applicant by the board or an authorized representative thereof.

The amendment shall take effect on the 1st day of May, 1962.
