Pursuant to our telephone conversation yesterday regarding an omission which occurred in this office in the preparation of Conservation Commission Order No. F-963, relating to lake trout fishing in Lake Superior, we enclose a corrected first page of this order which practically sets forth the sport fishing season for lake trout in Lake Superior as it was adopted by the Conservation Commission and as it appears in the minutes of the Conservation Commission meeting.

We, therefore, request that the pertinent pages of the Administrative Code be republished as necessary to make this correction. This will require the republication of page 90 of the Wisconsin Conservation Department section of the code.

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN
ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts and amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.02(1)(d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Table with 5 columns: WCD 20.02(1)(d), Species (Lake Trout), Location (Lake Michigan and Green Bay, Lake Superior), Season (Saturday nearest December 11 to September 30, By permit only from Saturday nearest November 6 to September 30), and Bag Limit (17, No bag limit).

Section WCD 20.02(1)(i) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 20.02(1)(i) All species of fish of lawful size may be taken from the outlying waters including Chequamegon Bay by trolling from a motor-driven or sailboat during the open season therefor. It shall be unlawful to spear any species or variety of fish in the outlying and reserve waters at any time, except that cary may be speared from sunrise to sunset in all outlying waters and may be taken with the use of spear guns by the method commonly known as skin diving by divers under the water in Lake Michigan. Northern pike may be speared through the ice in Lake Superior.

Section WCD 25.04(1)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Table with 5 columns: WCD 25.04(1)(a), Species (Lake Trout), Season (December 11 to September 30), Location (Lake Superior), and Bag Limit (NO OPEN SEASON).

Section WCD 25.04(2)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Table with 5 columns: WCD 25.04(2)(a), Species (Lake Trout), Length (17 inches), Location (Lake Superior), and Bag Limit (17 inches).

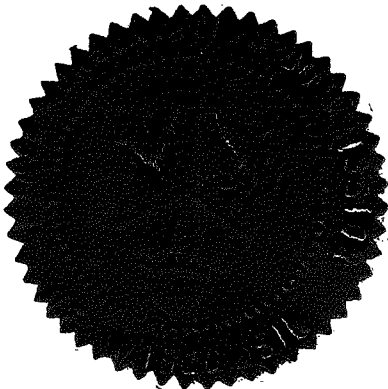

ADMINISTRATIVE CODE REVISIONS

Wisconsin by sections 29.065 and 29.17, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation
Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts and amends rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.02 (1)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is
amended to read:

WCD 20.02 (1)(a) Lake Trout Lake Michigan Saturday nearest the first of
and Green Bay December 11 to
September 30

Section WCD 20.02 (1)(1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is
amended to read:

WCD 20.02 (1)(1) ALL species of fish of inland state may be taken from
the ordinary waters including those upon any by trolling from a motor-driven
or sailboat during the open season therefor. It shall be unlawful to spear any
species or variety of fish in the ordinary and reserve waters at any time,
except that any may be speared from streams to named in all ordinary waters
and may be taken with the use of spear gun by the method commonly known as
spear diving by divers unless the water in Lake Michigan. No-taken fish may
be speared through the ice in Lake Superior.

Section WCD 25.04 (1)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is
amended to read:

WCD 25.04 (1)(a) Lake Trout December 11 to December 11 to NO OPEN
September 30 September 30 SEASON

Section WCD 25.04 (2)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is
amended to read:

WCD 25.04 (2)(a) Lake Trout 17 inches 17 inches



Section WCD 25.08 (3)(c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.08 (3)(c) During the closed season for whitefish no pond nets of any kind shall be used, set, placed, or operated in the waters of Lake Superior.

Section WCD 25.08 (3)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.08 (3)(b) Whenever any gill net set in the waters of Lake Michigan, northern Green Bay, and southern Green Bay for the purpose of catching herring, chubs, perch, muskellunge and smelt, and any gill net set in the waters of Lake Superior shall take illegal fish of any species, in an amount equal to more than 10% by weight of the total catch or 1470, they shall be deemed illegally set and shall be seized and held for the order of the court by the state conservation commission or its deputies, and the owners or operators thereof shall be subject to the penalties in section 29.53 (1)(b), Wis. Stats., unless such nets are immediately removed from such fishing grounds.

Section WCD 25.17 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 25.17 It shall be unlawful to spear any species or variety of fish in the outlying and reserve waters as any time, except that spear may be speared from sunrise to sunset in all outlying waters and may be taken with the use of spear guns by the method commonly known as skin diving by divers under the water in Lake Michigan.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on July 1, 1962.
