ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 156.03 (2), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby repeals and recreates Section H 16.03 relative to examination fees for funeral directors and embalmers as follows:

Section H 16.03 of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed and recreated to read:

H 16.03 Examination grade. Successful applicants must receive a general average of not less than 75 per cent.

The repeal and recreation as contained herein shall take effect on August 1, 1962 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats., subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wis. Stats.
