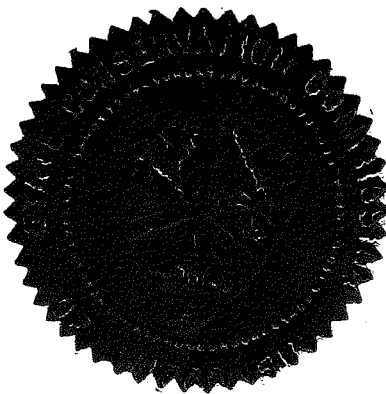

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING, AMENDING  
OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by section 29.17b, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 20.06(1)(e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 20.06(1)(e) Calderon Falls gaffs bait. The use of gaff hooks, firearms or fish spikes as an aid, and the use of suckers and chubs as bait, in the taking or landing of fish in the Calderon Falls reservoir from the Calderon Falls dam upstream to the county highway C bridge all in Marinette county is prohibited.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on August 1, 1962.
