**ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH
AMENDING RULES**

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3) and 140.05 (7), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby amends Subsection H 65.03 (2) relative to soil percolation test requirements for subdivisions not served by public sewers as follows:

Subsection H 65.03 (2) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

(2) The minimum lot areas shall be as follows:
