ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE

Repealing and Amending Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 200.03 (2), Wis. Stats., the Commissioner of Insurance hereby repeals and amends rules as follows:

Section Ins 3.13 (2) (j) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

Section Ins 3.15 (4) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

(a) In accordance with the provisions of section 204.322 (1) (f), Wis. Stats., the following are eligible for blanket accident and health insurance: 1. Volunteer fire departments, 2. National guard units, 3. Newspaper delivery boys, 4. Dependents of students, 5. Volunteer civil defense organizations, 6. Volunteer auxiliary police organizations, 7. Law enforcement agencies, 8. Cooperatives organized under chapter 185, Wis. Stats., on a membership basis without capital stock.

Section Ins 6.04 (2) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

(a) Policies issued in accordance with sections 201.44 (6), 201.44 (8), 202.08, or 209.04 (10) (c), (d), (e) and (f), Wis. Stats.;

The repeals and amendments contained herein shall take effect  
on May 1, 1963 as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
