I, John W. Thompson, Director of the Driver Control Division of the Motor Vehicle Department, State of Wisconsin, and legal custodian of the official records of said Driver Control Division, do hereby certify that the attached "Order Repealing, Vacating and Rescinding MVD 11.03 (21) of the published Wisconsin Administrative Code," was duly approved and adopted by James L. Karns, Commissioner of said department, this 1st day of April 1963; and,

That "Notice of Repeal of MVD 11.03 (21), Wisconsin Administrative Code," has been published in the Notice section of the Administrative Register, stating that said Order of Repeal will be made and entered, adopting said rule of repeal unless within 30 days after publication of said Notice it is petitioned for a public hearing by 25 persons who will be affected by the rule, a municipality which will be affected by the rule, or an association which is representative of a farm, labor, business or professional group which will be affected by said rule; and,

That no petition has been filed under 227.02 (1)(e), Wis. Stats., petitioning for a hearing relative to the vacating of the aforesaid rule.

ORDER REPEALING, VACATING AND
RESCINDING MVD 11.03 (21),
WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE

NOTICE having been given by publication in the February, 1963 Administrative Register for repealing MVD 11.03 (21), Wisconsin Administrative Code (the provision adding six additional points to each conviction for an incidental personal injury) provided under 343.32 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, and according to the procedure set forth under 227.02 (1) (e), Wisconsin Statutes; and,

The statutory thirty days as set forth in 227.02 (1) (e), Wisconsin Statutes having expired with no petition for a hearing having been filed by 25 persons who will be affected by the repeal of the rule, a municipality which will be affected by the rule, or an association which is representative of a farm, labor, business or professional group which will be affected by the rule, during such thirty-day statutory period;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that MVD 11.03 (21), of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is hereby repealed, vacated and rescinded effective immediately.
