ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin by sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wisconsin Statutes, the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts rules as follows:

Section WCD 21.09 (4) (d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 21.09 (d) It is unlawful for any person to set any gill net in the Wisconsin-Minnesota boundary waters of the Mississippi River or Lake Pepin within 300 feet of the mouth of any tributary stream to such boundary waters or to set any gill net in such tributary stream.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on May 1, 1964.
