ORDER OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by section 196.60, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission hereby adopts rules as follows:

Chapter PSC 164, Wisconsin Administrative Code, is adopted to read:

CHAPTER PSC 164

FILING OF INFORMATION BY TELEPHONE COMPANIES

PSC 164.01 Filing of information. Any public utility engaged in furnishing telephone service which determines to furnish service to its employes, pensioners, and officers at no charge or at charges less than those prescribed in its published schedules or teriffs, as provided in section 196.60, Wis. Stats., as amended by chapter 499, Laws of 1963, shall inform the Public Service Commission of Wisconsin as hereinafter prescribed of the conditions and circumstances under which it will be furnished.

PSC 164.02 Altered conditions of service. Every telephone public utility to which the foregoing is applicable shall file such information with the Public Service Commission in writing not later than 30 days after the effective date of these rules. In the event the terms and conditions of such service are altered, the utility shall file with the Commission an additional statement in writing setting forth in full such altered conditions.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on September 1, 1964, as provided in section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
