## ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Sections 140.05 (3), 140.09 (4), 141.015 (13) and 141.02 (2), Wisconsin Statutes, the State Board of Health hereby amends rule H 106.01 (introductory paragraph) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE relative to fraining and Experience Requirements for Health Officers, as follows:

H 106.01 (introductory paragraph) is amended to read:

H 106.01 Qualification requirements for non-medical health officers. To be eligible for appointment an applicant for non-medical health officer as required by sections 140.09 (4), 141.015 (13) and 141.02 (2), Wis. Stats., shall meet the training and experience requirements of subsections (1), (2), or (3):

The rule contained herein shall take effect on November 1, 1964 as provided in Section 227.026 (1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.225, Wisconsin Statutes.
