1. That pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service

mission repeals sections PSC 21.02, PSC 21.03, and PSC 21.04, Wis-  
consin Administrative Code.
2. That certified copies of the above repeal of rules be  
filed with the secretary of state and revisor of statutes, as  
required by section 227.023, Wis. Stats.

3. That the above repeal of rules become effective January 1, 1964 under the provisions of section 227.026(1), Wis. Stats.
