

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin by Section 101.01-101.29 Wisconsin Statutes, and pursuant to Chapter 227, the Industrial Commission on January 15, 1965 voted to repeal rule Ind 69.60 stated as follows:

Ind 69.60 Registration of sources of ionizing radiation. The fee to be levied on every operator registering under section 101.50 (7), Wis. Stats., shall be \$5.

The repeal shall become effective on the first day of the month following its publication in the Wisconsin Administrative code as provided in Section 227.
