

Pursuant to authority vested in the Industrial Commission of Wisconsin by Section 101.01 - 101.29 Wisconsin Statutes, and pursuant to Chapter 227, the Industrial Commission on October 19, 1964 voted to repeal and adopt rules as follows:

Chapter Ind 5 heretofore known as the Explosives Code of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, is repealed and Chapter Ind 5 known as Explosives and Blasting Agents Code is created. The newly created Chapter Ind 5 is attached.

The repeal and recreation of Chapter Ind 5 shall become effective on March 1, 1965 as provided in Section 227.026(1), Wisconsin Statutes.
