### EXTRACT ÆBON THE MINUTES OF THE STATE HIGHWAY CONVISSION OF WISCONSIN MEETING OF JUNE 1, 1965

## lo AINITITETATIVE BULIS - HIGHT PARKYHU RHOM ATTOM STORE:

The attention of the Commission was directed to the changes, which were proposed by the Commission on April 1, 1965, in its rules appearing in the Wisconsin Administrative Gode, which proposed changes were published in the Wisconsin Administrative Register for May, 1965.

No petition for a public hearing having been received during the statutory 30-day period provided for in Section 227.02(1) (e), Wisconsin Statutes, it was moved, seconded, and carried that the following additions of the Commission's rules be adopted, that the additions be filed, and that they take effect on the first day of the month following publication as provided in Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes:

# ORDER OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION ADOPTING ROLES

Pursuant to authority vasted in the State Righway Commission by Subsection 349.13(1), Visconsia Statutes, the State Mighway Commission hereby adopts rules as fellows:

Chapter By 16 '

Hy 16.01 General. (1) AVINORITY FOR THESE RULES. Pursuant to authority contained in section 349.13(1), Wis. State., the commission prescribes these rules relating to Might Perking Degulation signs.

- (2) FERMISSIVE INTERIM STANDARDS. Wight Parking Regulation signs in use by any afty or village prior to the affective date of these rules may remain in place and in use until June 30, 1967, but all signs initially exected after the effective date of these rules shall comply berewith.
- (3) REFECTIVE DATE. These rules shall be effective on July 1, 1965, or on the date specified by section 227,026, Wis. Stats., whichever is later.
- (4) ECOPE OF RUES. These rales specify the size of lettering, shape, and color of Might Parking Regulation signs which are intended to be eracted at or reasonably near the corporate limits of a city or village to advise motorists of regulations which apply on all atreets in the city or village. These rules do not apply to signs intended to be exected on individual streets to advise of specific parking regulations on that street even though such restrictions may be in effect during night hours.

- By 15.07 Detailed Design, (1) SITS OF LETTERING, The Primary togaid shall be in letters not less than five Inches in bright with a stroke which of 45/54-lach for 5-tach letters and proportionally greater for higher letters; the secondary legand in letters not less than those inches in height with a stroke width of 3/8-inch for 3-tach letters and proportionally greater for higher letters; and any minor supplementary legand in letters not less than one inch in height with a stroke width of 1/8-inch for 1-tach letters and proportionally greater for higher letters.
  - (a) The term primary legand, as used above, includes, but is not recessarily limited to, such phrases as: "No Parking," 30 Minute Parking," and "Alternate Elde Parking,"
  - (b) The term secondary legend, as used above, includes, but is not necessarily limited to, such phrases as: "Midnight to 7  $\rm AM_p^{11}$  "November 15 to flay 15," and "All City Streets."
  - (c) The term wisor supplementary legand, as used above, includes, but is not necessarily limited to, such phrones as: "City Ordinanca" and "Contack Police for Datails."
- (2) SHAPE. These signs shall be a recrangle with the longer sides vertical.
- (3) COLOR. These signs shall have black letters, numerals and border on a raffact wised white background.
