## ORDER OF THE STATE BANKING DEPARTMENT AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the commissioner of banks by Section 220.04 (6)(a), Wis. Stats., Section Bkg 4.03 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is adopted to read:

"Bkg 4.03 Maturity date of certificates. A state bank or trust company bank shall not issue any certificate of deposit the final maturity date of which is more than five years after the date of issuance."

The rule contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1966, as provided in Section 227.026 (1).
