## ORDER OF THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH

## AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Board of Health by Section 140.05 (3), Wis. Stats., and according to the procedure set forth in Section 227.02 (1) (e), Wis. Stats., the State Board of Health hereby amends the following rule:

Section H 71.08 (6) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read as follows:

H 71.08 (6) SAFETY LEDGE. When included, the safety ledge shall be at a constant depth of 30 to 60 inches and shall be 6 inches in width, with a slope of one-half inch from the wall toward the pool.

This amendment shall take effect on June 1, 1966 as provided in Sec. 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats, subject to approval under the provisions of Sec. 14.225, Wis. Stats.
