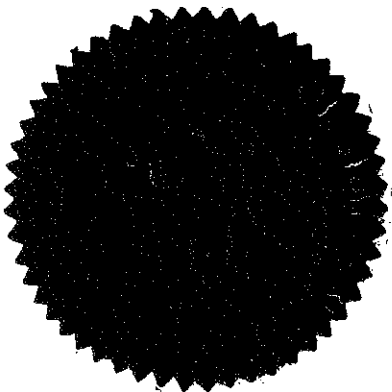

ORDER OF THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN

ADOPTING, AMENDING, REPEALING AND CREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin, by sections 29.085, 29.174 and 227.027, Wis. Stats., the State Conservation Commission of Wisconsin hereby adopts, amends, repeals and creates rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 20.16 (39) (a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 20.16 (39) Marquette county. . . . . (a) Fox river.

SECTION 2. WCD 21.03 (15) and (16) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are created to read:

WCD 21.03 (15) SALE PROHIBITED; EXCEPTIONS. No such fish shall be sold, purchased, bartered, offered for sale or had under control or in possession for the purpose of sale or barter at any time except legally taken and possessed rough fish at all times, catfish 15 inches or over in length in the round or 12 inches dressed with head off and tail on, hackleback sturgeons 25 inches or over, and bullheads during that period of time from the Saturday nearest May 1 to the following October 31.

(16) CRAYFISH. There shall be an open season for the taking of crayfish from the Saturday nearest May 1 to March 1, both dates

inclusive, with no bag limit and no size limit.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect the day of publication in the official state paper as provided in section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as emergency rules. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows: In the process of revising the 1967 Wisconsin Administrative Code, the preceding sections were inadvertently omitted. There is insufficient time to reinstate them through regular procedures prior to the fishing season. The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rules.


