ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.174, 23.09 and 29.085, Wisconsin Statutes, and Chapter 75, Laws of 1967, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION WCD 10.01 (4) (c) and (d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

WCD 10.01 (4) (c) Beaver

ZONE A	Open Season (both dates inclusive)	Bag Limit
In the counties of Florence, Forest, Iron, Langlade, Lincoln, Marinette, Menominee, Oconto, Oneida and Vilas	Jan. 13 through April 21	It is unlawful for any person to take in any zone more than the season bag limit established for such zone, and it is unlawful for any person to take more than a total combined season bag limit of 35 beaver in all the open season zones in the state.

ZONE B

All those parts of Buffalo,
Crawford, La Crosse, Trempealeau,
and Vernon Counties lying westerly
of a line beginning with the
junction of state highway 25
and the western boundary of the
state, thence easterly along said
highway 25 to its junction with the
CB&Q Railroad, thence southerly
along said railroad to its junction.

ZONE B (Cont.)	Open Season (both dates inclusive)	Bag Limit
with state highway 82, thence westerly along said highway 82 to its junction with the west boundary of the state.	Jan. 13 through Feb. 15	10

ZONE C

In the counties of Calumet, Dodge, Manitowoc, Outagamie, Ozaukee and Washington	None	---

ZONE D

In all other parts of the state	Jan. 13 through March 17	35

(d) Otter. The opening date for the trapping season for otter shall be concurrent with the opening date for trapping beaver in all zones established under paragraph (c) of this section. The open season for trapping otter shall extend through March 17 in Zone A and Zone D and through February 15 in Zone B. There shall be no open season in the counties of Brown, Calumet, Dodge, Door, Fond du Lac, Green Lake, Kewaunee, Manitowoc, Marquette, Outagamie, Ozaukee, Portage, Sheboygan, Washington, Waupaca, Waushara and Winnebago. The season bag limit is two otter. Each person who has trapped an otter will affix to such carcass immediately upon trapping a tag issued by the Wisconsin Division of Conservation. Upon request such tags will be issued free of charge by the Wisconsin Division of Conservation, Box 450, Madison, Wisconsin 53701.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1968.
