ORDER OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE  
AMENDING AND ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Department of Agriculture by section 97.022, Wis. Stats., the State Department of Agriculture hereby amends and adopts rules as follows:

1. Sections Ag 65.03 (2) (e) and (i) of the Wisconsin administrative code are amended to read:

Ag 65.03 (2) (e) Sodium nitrate, potassium nitrate, sodium nitrite, potassium nitrite or any combination thereof not exceeding 200 parts per million as nitrites in the final product; glucono delta lactone not exceeding 8 ounces to each 100 pounds of meat or meat byproduct.

(i) Cereal, vegetable starch, starchy vegetable flour, potato flour, nonfat dry milk, dry milk, calcium reduced dried skim milk (calcium reduced dried skim milk is skim milk which has been treated to replace a substantial portion of the calcium with sodium and subsequently dried to powder form), soya flour, soy protein concentrate, isolated soy protein to which has been added 0.10 per cent titanium dioxide, dried brewers yeast, and dried whey products. The weight of any such ingredient or combination of these ingredients shall not exceed 3-1/2 per cent by weight of the final product. Two per cent of isolated soy protein shall be considered the equivalent of 3-1/2 per cent of any other ingredient or combination of ingredients.

2. Section Ag 65.03 (2) (k) of the Wisconsin administrative

code is adopted to read:

Ag 65.03 (2) (k) Smoke flavor solution consisting essentially of a water extract of smoke produced by natural burning of hard wood under controlled conditions to insure purity and freedom from constituents which may be detrimental to human health.

3. Section Ag 65.03 (3) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 65.03 (3) Whenever any of the optional ingredients listed in subs. (2) (a) and (d) through ~~(j)~~ (k) are used, they shall be named on the label. Whenever any optional ingredient permitted by sub. (2) (c) is used, the term "lactic acid starter culture" shall be included in the list of ingredients on the label. Meat byproducts shall be identified on the label by the common or usual name of the anatomical part from which derived, such as beef tripe, sheep liver or pork snouts. Spices may be declared as spices or flavoring, but spice extractives shall be declared as flavoring. Whenever the optional ingredient "smoke flavor solution" is used, the label shall show the statement "smoke flavoring added".
