

ORDER OF THE

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by section 101.01 to 101.29, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby repeals and recreates rules as follows:

Section Ind 59.20<sup>(1)</sup> of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed and recreated to read:

Ind 59.20 Drawings, specifications and data. (1) DESIGN AND PREPARATION OF DRAWINGS. All drawings and data for the installation of heating, ventilating and air conditioning equipment shall be designed and prepared to satisfy the requirements of this code.

Note: See section 101.31 Wis. Stats., the provision of which regulates the practice of engineering and architecture in Wisconsin.

Designers are hereby notified that beginning on December 31, 1969, all drawings and design data to be submitted for review and approval under the provision of this code for buildings greater than fifty thousand (50,000) cubic feet shall be sealed or stamped by an engineer or architect registered in accordance with the laws of Wisconsin.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register as provided in section 227.026 (1).
