ORDER OF THE

DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by section 101.01 to 101.29, Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby repeals, recreates and adopts the rule as follows:

Section Ind 1.74 (3) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter 1, Safety is repealed and recreated to read:

- (3) The <u>cage</u> of every outdoor traveling crane shall be fully enclosed with windows on three sides.
 - (a) <u>Windows</u> shall provide ample vision for operators and may be fixed at the front and back. Side windows shall be openable.
 - (b) Doors
 - 1. If an integral outside platform is provided, the door shall be a sliding type or open outward.
 - 2. In the absence of an outside platform, the door shall open inward or slide and shall be self-closing.
 - (c) <u>Temperature</u>--A temperature reasonably comfortable for the operator shall be maintained in cold weather.

NOTE: See Ind 1.70 (1) Scope for types of equipment involved.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227.
