ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.174, 23.09 (7), 29.57 (4) and 227.027, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. WCD 10.12 (2) (c) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 10.12 (2) (c) It shall be lawful for any person to hunt wild ducks, wild geese and other aquatic fowl during the open season therefor in open water in any of the outlying waters of Lake Superior and Lake Michigan including Green Bay under the jurisdiction of the state of Wisconsin except the water area within 500 feet of any shoreline of said lakes and except the water area within 500 feet of any natural growth of vegetation extending over the water surface and of such height as to offer whole or partial concealment for the hunter.

SECTION 2. WCD 10.27 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is created to read:

WCD 10.27 DEER HUNTING IN STATE PARKS. An open season for deer is established on state owned lands in the following state parks pursuant to section 29.57 (4), Wis. Stats., as amended by Chapter 67, Laws of 1967, in accordance with the open season established in the respective season zone in which each such park is located, except for areas closed to deer hunting on Hartman Creek State Park, Mirror Lake State Park Recreation Area, Devil's Lake State Park and Perrot State Park.

(1) Gun season and December bow and arrow season only. Rock Island State Park, Europe Bay State Park, Big Boy State Park Recreation Area, Lake Wissota State Park Recreation Area, Tussockia-Park Falls State Trail, Elroy-Sparta State Trail, Mirror Lake State Park Recreation Area, Hartman Creek State Park, and Devil's Lake State Park.

(2) December bow and arrow season only. Perrot State Park.

SECTION 3. WCD 11.04 (10) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

SECTION 4. WCD 11.08 (20) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is renumbered to WCD 11.27 <sup>(13)</sup> ~~(11)~~.

SECTION 5. WCD 45.14 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

WCD 45.14 (1) Except as provided in Wis. Admn. Code section WCD 10.27, it shall be unlawful for any person to have in his possession or under his control any firearm or airgun as defined in section 939.22, Wis. Stats., unless the same is unloaded and enclosed in a carrying case, or any bow unless the same is unstrung or enclosed in a carrying case and no person shall take, catch, kill, hunt, trap, pursue or otherwise disturb any wild animals or birds in any state park or fish hatchery or in any campground or picnic area or contrary to posted notice on state forests, dikes in wildlife

areas or other areas under the management, supervision and control of the department of natural resources.

SECTION 6. WCD 45.14 (4) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the day of publication in the official state paper as provided in section 227.027, Wis. Stats., as emergency rules. Facts constituting the emergency are as follows:

The gun deer season this year opens on November 23. Without this emergency order, the rules relating to deer hunting would be ambiguous and conflicting and not in accord with the intention of the Natural Resources Board.

The waterfowl season opens October 12, consequently, this order must be processed as an emergency rule.

The preservation of the public safety and welfare necessitates the adoption of such rules as emergency rules.
