

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07 (1) and (10) and chapter 95, Wis. Stats., the Department of Agriculture hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Ag 10.16 (3) of the Wisconsin administrative code is amended to read:

Ag 10.16 (3) Official serum prophylaxis. Swine treated with anti-hog cholera serum or antibody concentrate shall be individually identified in a manner approved by the department to identify the swine as being so treated.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
