ORDER OF THE BOARD OF STATE BAR COMMISSIONERS AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board of State Bar Commissioners by Section 256.28(5), Wis. Stats., and Rule Bar 1.02(7), Wisconsin Administrative Code, the Board of State Bar Commissioners hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Bar 2.04(4) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is amended to read:

(4) In exceptional circumstances and for good cause, the board may waive the time limit for the filing of application and proofs, if the application is filed not less than thirty days before the examination and the applicant pays an additional fee of \$25. An application offered for filing less than thirty days before the examination will not be accepted unless the delay is due to service in the Armed Forces outside the continental limits of the United States.

The amendment contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1970.
