ORDER OF THE  
PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF WISCONSIN  
REPEALING AND RECREATING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Public Service Commission by chapters 194 and 227, Wis. Stats., the Public Service Commission amends rules as follows:

Section PSC 50.02 (1), (8), and (9), of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, are amended to read:

PSC 50.02 Restricted highways. (1) HIGHWAY 12 - Between its north junction with highway 15 and its junction with I-90--I-94 at Rocky Arbor, except where it is coincidental with highway 73 west of Cambridge, except from its intersection with highway I-90 east of Madison westerly to Middleton, and except where it is coincidental with highway 33 north of Baraboo.


(8) HIGHWAY 36 - Between Lake Geneva and Burlington.

(9) HIGHWAY 45 - Between the Illinois state line and Franklin and between West Bend and its junction with highway 175 south of Oshkosh except where it is coincidental with highway 20 in Racine County.

The amended rules contained herein shall take effect on March 1, 1970, as provided in section 227.026 (1), Wis. Stats.
