## ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRY, LABOR AND HUMAN RELATIONS

ADOPTING, AMENDING OR REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by section 101.01 to 101.29 Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby repeals rules as follows: Section Ind 70.12 is repealed:

PENALTIES. Any employer who employs any minor in violation of the permitted hours of labor as specified in section Ind 70.05 (1), and on the time of day as specified in section Ind 75.05 (2), (70.05) notwithstanding other statutory penalties, shall be required to pay to each minor time and one-half the regular rate of pay for all hours worked in violation per day or per week whichever is greater.

The repeals contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227 Wis. Stats.
