## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by Sections 29.174 and 227.02 (1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Section NR 20.04 (5)(a) 1. and 2. is amended to read:

## NR 20.04 (5) (a)

- 1. Peshtigo river--In, on or along that part of the Peshtigo river lying in Marinette county, beginning at the Johnson Falls dam in the SW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section 32, township 33 north, range 19 east, and extending downstream to the foot of Spring Rapids in the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of section 15, township 32 north, range 19 east, with a daily bag limit of 5 trout and a minimum size limit of 10 inches on trout.
- 2. Wolf river--In, on or along that part of the Wolf river lying in Langlade county, beginning at the railroad trestle in Section 19, township 32 north, range 14 east extending downstream to the east-west quarter line dividing the west half of

section 33, township 32 north, range 14 east marked by a road which runs along side the Diercks irrigation pond with a daily bag limit of 5 trout per day and a minimum size limit of 10 inches on trout.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on August 20, 1970, and November 10, 1970.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on January 1, 1971.
