



ORDER OF THE

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations by section 101.01 to 101.29 Wis. Stats., the Department of Industry, Labor and Human Relations hereby repeals, recreates, amends and adopts rules of Chapters Ind 41 and 42, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

The rules attached hereto shall become effective on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Code as provided in Section 227.
