


ORDER OF THE MEDICAL EXAMINING BOARD

Pursuant to authority vested in the Medical Examining Board by Chapter 448.03 (3)

Wis. Stats., the Board adopts the following rule:

Section Med. 9.09. Narcotic tax stamp. The holder of such a temporary license will surrender his narcotic tax stamp to the Medical Examining Board at the conclusion of his practice in Wisconsin.

The rule contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026 Wis. Stats.

Med 9.01 Basic science certificate required. A Wisconsin basic science certificate must be obtained by either written examination or reciprocity. For information on this subject, the applicant may write directly to the secretary of that board.

Med 9.02 Requirements. Applicant must be licensed in a state with which the Wisconsin medical examining board has reciprocity. The applicant must be a graduate of an A.M.A. approved medical school and must submit the following:

- (1) Notarized photostatic copy of his state medical license obtained by written examination or national board certificate or federated licensing examination.
- (2) Notarized photograph of applicant.
- (3) Blue copy of his Wisconsin basic science certificate.
- (4) Completed formal application blank.
- (5) Biographical background information on applicant's education and qualifications.
- (6) Approval of the chairman of the Wisconsin medical examining board.
- (7) Fee of \$25.

Med 9.03 Recommendation required by a responsible individual or organization. Establishment of the "need" shall be aided by the recommendation of an individual, private practitioner or camp organization. Final decision will rest with the board or its duly elected officers.

Med 9.04 Fee. A fee of \$25 shall be charged for each license granted.

Med 9.05 Expiration. A temporary license shall, according to statute, be granted to those properly qualified and shall expire after 90 days from the date of issuance.

Med 9.06 Revocation. A violation of any provision of this temporary camp physician or locum tenens code or of section 448.18 or 448.19 of the medical practice act, shall constitute cause for revocation of such temporary license.

Med 9.07 Renewals. For cause shown to the satisfaction of the medical examining board, the temporary license at the discretion of the examining board may be renewed for additional periods of 90 days each in the case of a physician serving on a temporary basis. Renewal fee is \$25.

Med 9.08 Practice limitations. The holder of such a temporary license may engage in the regular practice of medicine and surgery according to the Wisconsin statutes, providing such practice is confined to the geographical area for which the license is granted.
