the purpose of bringing the language of the existing rules
into conformity with Section 256.28(2), Wisconsin Statutes,

IT IS ORDERED that the rules for examination of
applicants for admission to the bar be and the same are
hereby amended as follows:

1. Bar 1.01(4) and Bar 1.01(5) are amended by
deleting from each of said rules the words "Council of
Legal Education and Admissions to the Bar of the".

2. The list of subjects appearing in Bar 1.08(1)
is deleted.

3. Bar 1.08(1) is amended as follows:

Bar 1.08 Examination of applicants. (1) Examinations
of applicants by the board shall include written questions ~~and~~
~~may include optional or alternative questions~~ upon some or all
of the following subjects/ listed in Sec. 256.28(1)(b) Stats.


