Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Natural Resources by 227.02 (2) (b), Wis. Stats., the Department of Natural Resources hereby repeals, amends and adopts rules as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter RD 2 is renumbered to Chapter NR 102.

SECTION 2. RD 2.01 is renumbered to NR 102.01.

SECTION 3. NR 102.01 (3) is amended to read:

(3) Test procedures shall conform with "Standard Methods for the Examination of Water and Wastewater," 12th Edition, 1965, prepared and edited by the American Public Health Association, American Waterworks Association and Water Pollution Control Federation, or by other methods acceptable to the department of researce development natural resources and not contrary to the requirements of the federal government. The U. S. Atomic Energy Commission Rules and Regulations, Title 10, Part 20, Standards for Protection Against Radiation, December 22, 1965, will apply to the disposal and permissible concentrations of radioactive substances.

(d) The intake water supply will be such that by appropriate treatment and adequate safeguards it will meet the Public Health Service Drinking Water Standards, 1962.
