

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

Adopting, Amending, or Repealing Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Superintendent of Public Instruction by Section 115.28 (5), Wisconsin Statutes, and in accordance with the procedure set forth in section 227.02 (1) (e), Wisconsin Statutes, he hereby repeals, amends, and adopts rules as follows:

PI 2.01 (1) is amended to read:

PI 2.01 (1) "APPEALS" are matters appealed to the state superintendent for determination pursuant to the provisions of the Wisconsin Statutes.

PI 2.01 (2) is amended to read:

PI 2.01 (2) "STATE SUPERINTENDENT" as used here includes assistant state superintendents or his designated representative and supervisors whenever detailed by the state superintendent for discharging the duties and exercising powers of the state superintendent on appeals.

PI 2.03, intro par., is amended to read:

PI 2.03 Other requirements. Within a reasonable time after filing an appeal, there shall be supplied the following:

and PI 2.03⁽²⁾ is repealed.

PI 2.03 (3) is renumbered PI 2.03 (2) and amended to read:

PI 2.03 (2) Copy of notice of meeting on petition or resolution.

PI 2.03 (4) is renumbered PI 2.03 (3).

PI 2.03 (5) is renumbered PI 2.03 (4) and amended to read:

PI 2.03 (4) Minutes of meeting constituting the hearing on the petition or resolution.

PI 2.03 (6) is renumbered PI 2.03 (5).

PI 2.03 (7) is renumbered PI 2.03 (6) and amended to read:

PI 2.03 (6) The foregoing shall be certified by the secretary or clerk of said meeting and when necessary shall be accompanied by a written statement, by appellants, of facts and other relevant matters relating to the appeal.


PI 2.04 is amended to read:

PI 2.04 Notice. Notice of filing of an appeal and notice of hearing will be sent by the state superintendent by mail to the clerk of each municipality and school district affected by the appeal.

PI 2.05 (6) is amended to read:

PI 2.05 (6) Informal conferences noticed and held by the state superintendent either at his office or at a convenient place in the area concerned that may be designated by him.
