## ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.174, 23.09, 29.085 and Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION NR 10.01 (4)(c) and (d) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is repealed and recreated to read:

NR 10.01 (4)(c) Beaver

Open Season (both dates inclusive) Bag Limit

It is unlawful for any person to take in any zone more than the season bag limit established for such zone, and it is unlawful for any person to take more than a total combined season bag limit of 50 beaver in all the open season zones in the state.

ZONE A

All that part of Wisconsin lying northerly of State Highway 29

Dec. 11 through Apr. 2

ZONE B

All that part of Buffalo, La Crosse, Trempealeau and Vernon Counties lying westerly of State Highway 35, that part of Crawford County beginning with the junction of State Highway 35 and the Vernon County line, thence southerly along said Highway 35 to its

junction with U.S. Highway 18, thence westerly along said Highway 18 to its junction with the C.B.&Q. Railroad, thence southerly along said railroad to its junction with the Grant County line and that part of Grant County lying westerly of the C.B.&Q. Railroad

ZONE C

All other parts of the state

(d) Otter. The opening date for the trapping season for otter shall be concurrent with the opening date for trapping beaver in all zones established under paragraph (c) of this section. The open season for trapping otter shall extend through February 13 in Zone A, Zone B and Zone C. The season bag limit is two otter in Zone A and one otter in Zone B and Zone C. Each person who has trapped an otter will affix to such carcass immediately upon trapping a tag issued by the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources. Upon request such tags will be issued free of charge by the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, Box 450, Madison, Wisconsin 53701.

The rules, amendments and repeals contained herein shall take effect December 1, 1971.
