BY EMERGENCY RULE UNDER
227.02(1) (c) and 227.027, WIS. STATS.,
WITHOUT NOTICE AND PUBLIC
HEARING

Pursuant to authority vested in the Di-
vision of Motor Vehicles of the Depart-
ment of Transportation of the State of
Wisconsin under Sec. 347.45 (2) (c) 1,
Wisconsin Statutes, the division finds that
an emergency exists and that the amend-
ment included below is necessary for the
immediate preservation of the public wel-
fare.

A statement of the facts constituting the
emergency is as follows: Experience has
shown that studded tires cause excessive
wear on the highways, and that the period
of usage should be shortened. The present
rule permits use of studs beginning on
October 15, and the standard rule-making
procedure would not allow for a later date
to be established this year.

The amendment to MVD 16 (1), Wiscon-
sin Administrative Code, is therefore
adopted as an emergency rule to take
effect upon publication and filing with the
Secretary of State and the Revisor of
Statutes as provided in Sec. 227.027, Wis.
Stats.

The rule is amended as follows:

MVD 16.01 Studded tires. (Section 347.45
(2) (c) 1 and 4, Wis. Stats.) (1) Tungsten
carbide studded tires may be used on
vehicles specified in this subsection an-
nually from the * * * 12th day of * * *
November each year to the 15th day of
April.

(2) Studded tires for heavier vehicles or
not specifically covered by statute, may
be used for study only after written ap-
proval of the Administrator of usage in
a c c o r d a n c e with the purpose of this
subsection.

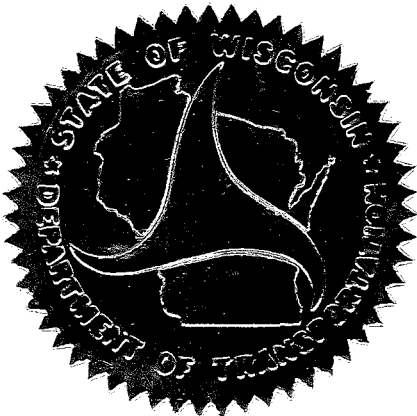
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Pursuant to authority vested in the Division of Motor Vehicles of the Department of Transportation of the State of Wisconsin under Sec. 347.45(2)(c)1, Wisconsin Statutes, the Division finds that an emergency exists and that the amendment included below is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public welfare.

A statement of the facts constituting the emergency is as follows:
Experience has shown that studded tires cause excessive wear on the highways, and that the period of usage should be shortened. The present rule permits use of studs beginning on October 15, and the standard rule-making procedure would not allow for a later date to be established this year.

The amendment to MVD 16 (1), Wisconsin Administrative Code, is therefore adopted as an emergency rule to take effect upon publication and filing with the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes as provided in Sec. 227.027, Wis. Stats.

The rule is amended as follows:

- MVD 16.01 Studded tires. [Section 347.45 (2)(c) 1 and 4, Wis. Stats.]
(1) Tungsten carbide studded tires may be used on vehicles specified in this subsection annually from the ~~15th~~ 12th day of ~~October~~ November each year to the 15th day of April.
(2) Studded tires for heavier vehicles or not specifically covered by statute, may be used for study only after written approval of the Administrator of usage in accordance with the purpose of this subsection.
