ORDER ADOPTING

Pursuant to authority vested in the Administrator of the Division of Motor Vehicles of the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation under Section 348.185, Wis. Stats., and in accordance with Chapter 227, Wis. Stats., and after due notice and public hearing held the 12th day of May 1972, at the Hill Farms State Office Building, 4802 Sheboygan Avenue, Madison, Wisconsin; and, after giving due consideration to the objections and suggestions of those persons attending such public hearing relative to the various portions of the rule;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, That Section MVD 4.05, of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, relative to an alternate rule for indicating empty weight on vehicles, be adopted as follows:

MVD 4.05 Alternate Rule for Indicating Empty Weight on Vehicles.

An alternate method for indicating empty weight to that required by Section 348.185, Wis. Stats., is to type or write the empty weight of the vehicle on the registration certificate, which certificate shall be carried in or on the vehicle.
