ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by Sections 29.085 and 29.174, Wisconsin Statutes, the Natural Resources Board hereby amends and repeals rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 20.03 (1)(h) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

SECTION 2. NR 25.02 (5) of the Wisconsin, Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.02

(5) All waters in Lake Michigan within one-half mile from the shoreline of Milwaukee, Racine and Kenosha counties.

SECTION 3. NR 25.04 (1)(a) and (2)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code are repealed.

SECTION 4. NR 25.06 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 25.06 PROTECTED FISH. All black bass, rock bass, crappie, muskellunge, sturgeon, salmon, illegal whitefish, all species of trout and all other illegal fish caught or taken alive and unharmed in any licensed fishing gear shall be immediately and carefully returned to the water alive. When found dead in such gear, they shall be turned over to the department of natural resources or its authorized agents.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on June 8, 1972.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on August 1, 1972.
