
TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD
ADOPTING AND AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by section 144.025, Wisconsin Statutes, the Natural Resources Board hereby adopts and amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 104.02 (1) (a) is amended to read:

NR 104.02 (1) (a) Badfish Creek from the east limits of the Village of Oregon to the Dane-Rock County line.

SECTION 2. NR 104.02 (6) (a) is created to read:

NR 104.02 (6) The following surface waters must meet the minimum standards and those for fish and other aquatic life:

(a) Badfish Creek from the Dane-Rock County line downstream to the confluence with the Yahara River.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on September 7, 1972.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
