

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & SOCIAL SERVICES REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services in Section 140.05, Wis. Stats., and in accordance with Chapter 227, Wis. Stats., the Department of Health & Social Services hereby repeals rules relating to restaurants as follows:

Section H 96.05 (8) & (9) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed.

The repeal contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026, Wis. Stats., subject to approval under the provisions of Section 14.06, Wis. Stats.
