ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD  
ADOPTING, AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 29.085, 29.174, 23.09 and 227.02, Wisconsin Statutes, the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 10.01 (1)(e) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 10.01 (1)

Kind of Animal and Locality

Open Season  
(Both Dates Inclusive)

Bag Limit

(g) ~~(e)~~ Woodcock - Entire State

Beginning on the Saturday nearest September 15 and continuing for 65 consecutive days.

SECTION 2. NR 10.01 (3)(f) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 10.01 (3)

(f) Fox, all species

1. Hunting and trapping season

a. In the counties of Buffalo, Calumet, Chippewa, Crawford, Dane, Dunn, Eau Claire, Grant, Green, Jackson, Jefferson, Juneau, La Crosse, Lafayette, Oconto,

<u>Kind of Animal and Locality</u>	<u>Open Season (Both Dates Inclusive)</u>	<u>Bag Limit</u>
Ozaukee, Pierce, Polk, Price, Rock, Rusk, St. Croix, Sauk, Shawano, Trempealeau, Vernon, Vilas, Walworth, Washington, Waukesha, Wood	Beginning on Saturday nearest October 15 through February 28	None
b. In all other parts of the state	All year	None

SECTION 3. NR 10.27 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:  
NR 10.27 Deer hunting in state parks.

Open seasons for deer are established on state-owned lands in the following state parks as hereinafter set forth pursuant to Sec. 29.57 (4), Wis. Stats., in accordance with the open season established by Sec. NR 10.01 (3)(e) in the respective season zone in which such park is located, except for areas closed to deer hunting.

(1) Gun season only; Governor Dodge state park

(2) Gun season and December bow and arrow season only; Rock Island state park, Europe Bay state park, Big Bay state park recreation area, Lake Wissota state park recreation area, Tuscobia-Park Falls state trail, Elroy-Sparta state trail, Mirror Lake state park recreation area, Hartman Creek state park, Devil's Lake state park, Interstate state park, Wildcat Mountain state park and Willow River state park.

(3) In all other state parks there is no open season for hunting deer.

SECTION 4. NR 11.27 (16)(a) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

(16) Shawano county (a) Navarino

Township 25 north, range 16 east

Sec. 2 - All that part of the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and of the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 lying west of a posted line.

Sec. 3 - All that part of the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 and of the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 lying east of the railroad tracks.

Sec. 5 - All that part of the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 lying west of STH 187.

Sec. 6 - All that part of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 lying east and south of a posted line which lies parallel to the main dike.

Sec. 7 - SE 1/4 NE 1/4, all that part of the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 and the W 1/2 of the NE 1/4 and the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 lying east of a posted line which lies parallel to the main dike, N 1/2 of the SE 1/4.

Sec. 8 - All that part of the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SW 1/4 NW 1/4 and the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 lying west of STH 187.

Sec. 9 - NE 1/4, E 1/4 of the NW 1/4, all that part of the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 lying north of the service road.

The foregoing rules and regulations were approved by the Natural Resources Board on September 20, 1972, and will take effect upon publication.
