ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN NATURAL RESOURCES BOARD

AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board by sections 144.31 and 144.36, Wisconsin Statutes, the Natural Resources Board hereby amends rules as follows:

SECTION 1. NR 154.01 (41) (6) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

NR 154.01 (41) (6) is amended to read: NR 154.01 (41) (c).

SECTION 2. NR 154.01 (41) (c) 3. is amended to read:

NR 154.01 (41) (c) 3. SO₂ and particulate combined - product of SO₂ ppm, 24-hour average and COHs, 24-hour average equal to 1.2 or the product of SO₂ μg/m³, 24-hour average and particulate μg/m³, 24-hour average equal to 393 x 10³.

SECTION 3. NR 154.01 (41) (c) 4. is amended to read:

NR 154.01 (41) (c) 4. The CO dose is equal to or greater than 320 ppm - hr. (368 mg - hr/m³) for any consecutive 8-hour period in the preceding 16 hours.

The foregoing rules were approved and adopted by the State of Wisconsin Natural Resources Board on September 7, 1972.

The rules contained herein shall take effect upon publication.
