ORDER ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Historical Society of Wisconsin by sections 44.21, Wis. Stats., the Board of Curators of the State Historical Society of Wisconsin hereby adopts the following rule:

HS 1:01 Parking is prohibited at all times on the grounds of the State Historical Society of Wisconsin located at 816 State Street, Madison, Wisconsin, except for vehicles owned by the Society, and such other vehicles as may be allowed by the director of the Society who may issue parking permits which shall be affixed to the vehicles so allowed; the parking area or areas shall be appropriately posted. Violation of this section shall result in a forfeiture to the state of not more than \$25.00 as established by the board of curators pursuant to the authority of ch. 170, laws of 1971.

The rule shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE REGISTER, pursuant to section 227.026, Wis. Stats.
