ORDER OF THE VETERINARY EXAMINING BOARD AMENDING AND REPEALING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Veterinary Examining Board by sec. 15.08 (5), Wis. Stats., and sec. 453.06, Wis. Stats., the Veterinary Examining Board hereby adopts rules as follows:

VE 2.08 TEMPORARY PERMIT

- (1) A graduate of a veterinary college approved by the Board who meets all requirements for examination may be granted a permit to practice veterinary medicine until the next examination is given provided he is employed and supervised by a licensed veterinarian. Applicants for such temporary permit must provide:
 - (a) Proof of graduation
 - (b) Permit fee of \$25.00
 - (c) Three letters of recommendation
 - (d) Letter from the licensed veterinarian agreeing to employ and supervise applicant.
- (2) The applicant must personally appear before the Board in order to obtain such temporary permit.
- (3) Permits shall not be extended beyond the examination date nor granted to candidates for license who have once failed the examination.

The rules contained herein shall take effect on the first day of the month following publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register or as otherwise provided in sec. 227.026, Stats.
