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

ORDER OF THE STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
AMENDING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture by sections 93.07(1) and (12) and 94.56, Wis. Stats., the State of Wisconsin Department of Agriculture hereby amends rules as follows:

1. Chapter Ag 16 (title) of the Wis. Adm. Code is amended to read:

Ag 16 REFUSE AND DUNNAGE DISPOSAL AT GREAT LAKE PORTS.

2. Section Ag 16.01(1) of the Wis. Adm. Code is amended to read:

Ag 16.01 Definitions. (1) "Refuse" means any waste material containing any plant or animal matter.

3. Section Ag 16.04(9) of the Wis. Adm. Code is amended to read:

Ag 16.04(9) Unless other treatment or disposal is approved by the department, all refuse and dunnage removed from a vessel shall be transported directly to an incinerator for immediate incineration.

The rules contained herein shall take effect July 1, 1973.
