

ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION

Adopting, Amending, or Repealing Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the State Superintendent of Public Instruction by section 43.03 and section 43.09, Wisconsin Statutes (Chapter 152, Laws of 1971), she hereby repeals, amends, and adopts rules as follows:

Section PI 6.03(2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

PI 6.03(2) Applications for librarian certificates under this section shall be made in writing to the division, and with each application for a grade 1 certificate, as provided in subsection (3)(a) below, shall be paid a fee of \$5, and with each application for a grade 2 and a grade 3 certificate, as provided in subsections (3)(b) and (3)(c) below, shall be paid a fee of \$3.
