ORDER OF THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE

Amending Rules

Pursuant to authority vested in the Commissioner of Insurance by section 601.41 (3), Wis. Stats., the Commissioner of Insurance hereby amends rules as follows:

Section Ins 5.01 (2) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Ins 5.01 (2) "Commissioner" as used herein includes the deputy commissioner whenever detailed by the commissioner or discharging the duties and exercising the powers of the commissioner during his absence or a vacancy in the office of the commissioner, all as provided by section 601.11 (1) (b), Wis. Stats.

Section Ins 6.11 (1) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code is amended to read:

Ins 6.11 (1) PURPOSE. This rule is to promote the fair and equitable treatment of policyholders, claimants and insurers by defining certain claim adjustment practices which are considered to be unfair methods and practices in the business of insurance. The rule implements and interprets applicable statutes including but not limited to section 201.045 (1), 601.01 (3) (b), and 645.41 (3), Wis. Stats.

Section Ins 6.50 (2) (h) is amended to read:

Ins 6.50 (2) (h) <u>Casualty Insurance</u> - as described in section 201.04 (5), (6) and (7), except bail bond insurance, and 201.04 (8), (9), (10), (11), (13), (15), (16), (17), (18), (19) and

(20), Wis. Stats., (includes the lines of insurance listed in subsection (2) (i), (j), (l), (m) and (n) of this rule.
