As provided in Section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes, there is hereby submitted a certified copy of Section H 45.40(1)(b) of the Wisconsin Administrative Code relative to streptococcal infections as adopted by the Health and Social Services Board on January 9, 1974, for publication in the Wisconsin Administrative Register. As permitted in Section 227.02(1)(e), Wisconsin Statutes, these amendments were adopted without public hearing, no petition for hearing having been received in the 30-day period following publication of the proposed amendments in the Wisconsin Administrative Register on October 1, 1973. It is hoped that the rules can be published in the February issue of the Register.

A copy of these rules are also being submitted to the Governor as required by Section 14.06 and to the Secretary of State as required by Section 227.023, Wisconsin Statutes.


ORDER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES ADOPTING RULES

Pursuant to authority vested in the Department of Health and Social Services in Sections 140.05 and 143.02(4), Wisconsin Statutes, and in accordance with Chapter 227, Wisconsin Statutes, the following rules are hereby promulgated.

Section H 45.40(1)(b) of the WISCONSIN ADMINISTRATIVE CODE is repealed and recreated to read:

H 45.40(1)(b) Restrictions. A patient, who is not receiving adequate antibiotic therapy, should be isolated until clinical recovery, or no less than 7 days from onset. Isolation of a patient may be terminated after 24 hours of treatment with penicillin or other effective antibiotic. Antibiotic therapy should be continued for 10 days.

The rules contained herein shall take effect as provided in Section 227.026(1), Wisconsin Statutes, subject to the provisions of Section 14.06, Wisconsin Statutes.
